## TNI Leads Mission to Accelerate Peace and Development in Papua

Notably, TNI recently executed a successful humanitarian mission following the murder of New Zealand pilot Glen Malcolm Conning, who was tragically killed while working in Papua. Without any formal request, TNI forces responded promptly, securing the area, evacuating the victim's remains, and providing aid to other civilians caught in the turmoil. In another operation, TNI led a joint mission to release Susi Air Pilot Captain Phillip Mark Mehrtens, a significant achievement in fostering safety in the region.

Colonel Yogi Nugroho, Commander of the HABEMA Media Task Forces, emphasized the TNI's unwavering commitment to supporting the government's development agenda: "The TNI and Polri Security Forces will continue working relentlessly to ensure Papua remains safe, secure, and free from disruptions. Our mission is not just about security; it's about enabling welfare development for all of Papua."

With a continued focus on professionalism, integration, and adaptability, the TNI stands at the forefront of promoting peace and accelerating welfare initiatives in Papua. As the region moves towards a more stable future, TNI's role in fostering unity and development marks a hopeful new chapter for Papua and its people.
